

## How to Be Saved According To the Bible

### The Four Spiritual Laws

(1) *You Are A Sinner*

**Romans 3:23**

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,

(2) *Your Sins Separate You From God*

**Isaiah 59:2**

But your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, And your sins have hidden His face from you so that He does not hear.

(3) *God Loves You and Jesus Died For You*

**Romans 5:8**

But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

(4) *In Order To Be Saved You Must Accept Jesus as Your Lord and Savior*

**John 1:12**

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, *even* to those who believe in His name,

### You Accept Jesus by Meeting the Following Five Conditions

(1) *Faith*

**John 3:16**

For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life.

(2) *Repentance*

**Luke 13:3**

I tell you, no, but unless you repent, you will all likewise perish.

(3) *Confession of Jesus*

**Romans 10:9**

That if you confess with your mouth Jesus *as* Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved;

(4) *Baptism by Immersion*

**Acts 2:38**

Peter said to them, Repent, and each of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins; and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

(5) *Remaining Faithful To Jesus Until Death*

**Matthew 24:13**

But the one who endures to the end, he will be saved.

## Notes

The five conditions of accepting Jesus as your Lord and Savior are conditions of “receiving” not of “achieving”. Eternal life is a free gift that was purchased and paid for completely and entirely by the shed blood of Jesus when He died on the cross. You do not add to that in any way when you accept God’s offer of free salvation. You simply accept God’s offer.

Faith and belief is the same thing in the Bible. Faith (belief) is trusting Jesus for salvation and trusting Jesus to tell you how to live your life.

Repentance is a change of the mind caused by a sorrow for sin and leading to a reformation of life.

The term “Confession”, as used in these verses, refers to confession of Jesus as the Christ, the Son of the Living God; not to a confession of your sins. Confession of sins is something all Christians do, but it is not what these verses mean.

Bible baptism is immersion in water of a repentant believer in Jesus. If you did not believe in Jesus at the time you were baptized, then it was not true baptism.

The phrase “remain faithful until death” does not mean that you are living a perfect, sinless life. It means that you are continuing to trust in Jesus and Jesus alone to save you.
